

Bespoke Frame Bag Sizing Instructions

We make all **Bespoke Frame Bags** to fit your bike's frame. To do this we need to make a template for your bike's inner frame triangle. To keep things accurate and simple, you can supply the information we need with a special photo of your bike. Read on to see what we need.



1. Tape a ruler to the top tube of your bike. We need to see 15-20cm clearly (Figure 1)
2. For partial frame bags please make sure you leave your water bottles in your cages. The size and style of your bottles and cages is super important!
3. Place your bike against something, so that it's stood up perfectly straight, make sure it's not leaning at all.
4. Take a photo of your bike, with the best quality device you have. We want the biggest file size you can get. Follow these tips for the perfect shot:
 - A. Crouch down in the centre of the bike, put the camera in the centre of the frame
 - B. The bikes fork blades and stays should line up behind each other, it should look like a flat 2D Bike.
 - C. Take a photo of the whole bike first, and check this to see that you are square on with the centre.
 - D. Then take a photo of just the triangle.
 - E. If your bike has sideways cable entry on the Non-Drive Side it's helpful to have a photo of that too!
